Next, take a short walk through the **National Petascale Computing Facility** where you will get a first-hand look at **Blue Waters**—the fastest supercomputer on a college campus and one of the most powerful supercomputers in the world.





Take a step back in time on the historic railway

Arrive at the historic **Monticello Railway Museum** where you taste the true history of the Illinois Central Railroad. After exploring railcars and other equipment, you will board a historic train car for a lunch you will never forget! Tour a stunning European-inspired estate

See why **Allerton Park and Retreat Center** is listed in the National Register of Historic Places and named one of the American Institute of Architects' 150 Great Places in Illinois. Built as a private residence in 1900, today Allerton Park and Retreat Center is a historical treasure owned by the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign. Befitting a splendid Georgian Manor House, the formal gardens feature extensive plantings and over 100 ornaments and sculptures for your group to discover.



Dinner at Alexander Steakhouse

Discover the art of "Eatertainment" at Alexander's Steakhouse—home of the "cook your own steak!" Enjoy a fresh salad bar, select your own steak from one of their meat lockers and cook your own on one of the large indoor grills.
